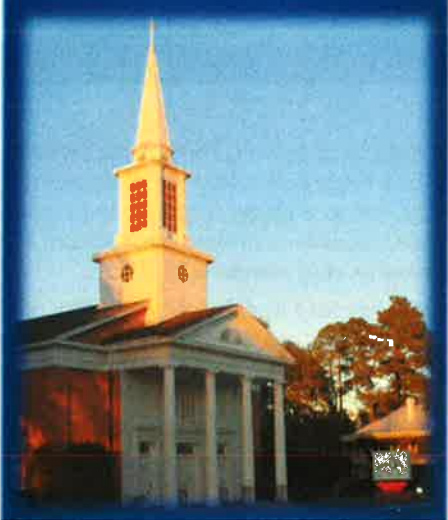

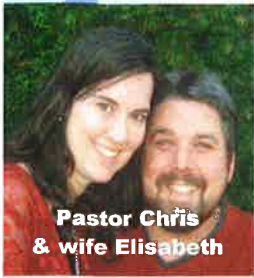

Are you having church today? Where is your church? Do you go to church? What time is church?

These questions, and many like it, expose what I call the "church fallacy". The idea that church is a place we go to or an event we participate in. The Biblical truth is that church is a name for a people. Back in 2011, I interviewed for a pastoral position with a search committee in North Carolina that expressed this well. Though we did not end up accepting their offer to be considered for the position, one thing they shared during the interview I never forgot. They shared how their founding pastor had stressed for them to *be* the church. To drive his point home even further, one Sunday he had them cancel all their services for the day. Notice, I said they cancelled their "services", but not church. On that particular Sunday, the pastor challenged them to go out and *be* the church by doing mission projects in the community. So, instead of assembling in a building, they spread out to love their community and share Jesus. The people grew to understand that church was not a building, a worship service, or a time on a particular day. The church was who they were as a people. I thought of this recently when services were cancelled in North Carolina due to snow and when services were cancelled in Georgia due to tornadic activity. If believers understood who they were in Jesus, they would know that church wasn't cancelled. The assembly of the church was. The church was still to *be* church and *do* church wherever they were.

So, when you are worshipping and glorifying God in all you do, all day, every day (1 Corinthians 10:31) you are "having" church by *being* the church. The only way church can ever truly be "cancelled" is if you stop *being* the church. As Hebrews points out, the assembling together of the church is commanded and important (Hebrews 10:24-25). But, we are never to mistake that as the totality of our identity or calling. Nor should we think that Sundays are the only days "church" happens. All through the week the church should be assembling together and doing missions together.

Get out there and have church by being the church and inviting others to the assembly of the church. You never know. It might lead to a new member of the church.
