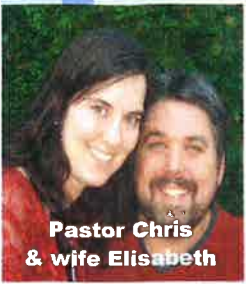

He said, "Thank you".


I had my annual check-up recently. I was weighed. My height was measured. My temperature was taken. My doctor poked, listened, asked, and took notes. I gave blood. In the end, everything was good. During my visit, he said something to me that caught me off guard and I don't think I'll ever forget. He said, "Thank you." He had just noted that I had lost significant weight since my last physical. I shared that I had "been working on it" and had even added a few of the pounds back recently. Still, I was much lighter than a year before. He was pleased and affirmed my progress and then looked at me and said, "Thank you". Why would my doctor thank me? Shouldn't I be thanking him for checking on me each year and for encouraging me to be healthy? But, in that moment, when he said those two words, I totally understood. As a pastor, even more so, I understood. He thanked me because it affirmed his

work. He thanked me because, even though I was doing this for myself, it also communicated that I was listening to him. Seeing my progress, he felt he was making progress, even if for only one patient. I remember leaving thinking, "If a church member ever wanted to encourage their pastor, it would be by putting into practice what we preach." When a pastor sees a church member diving deeper in the word, sharing their faith with another, incorporating Biblical principles in their decisions, that is when we feel affirmed in what we do. And, that is when we ought to say, "Thank you". I'm sure we don't say it enough. So, to those members who are striving to listen each week, take notes, live out the Scriptures and glorify God in all things, I say, "Thank you". You make me smile. You give me hope. You inspire me to press on. You encourage me to try and reach one more.
