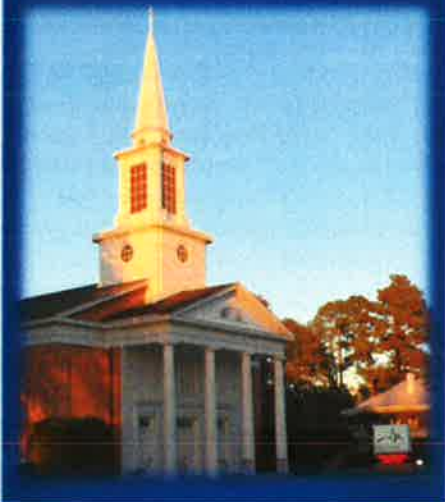

The time is here...and we are excited to have an opportunity to serve God and minister to the children in the days ahead.

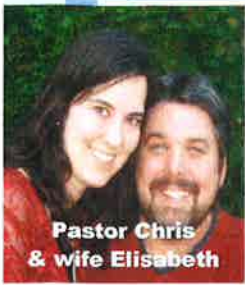
Listed below is a daily schedule of Bible lesson themes and verses that we will be covering. Please be in prayer for the VBS Team as we share the love of Christ with His precious children.
