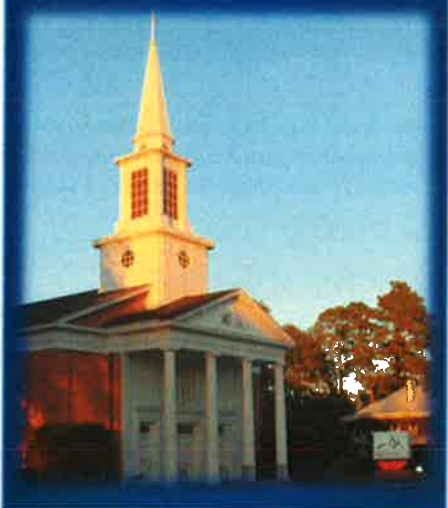

 And in other parts is much worse, people are being evacuated, many lost their houses and well we hope it stops raining up on the mountains soon. The people who lived closed to the different rivers were the ones affected the most.
 Also, roads were close so food is getting scarce and I hope it doesn't get too expensive.
